THEME: Service in the Stars

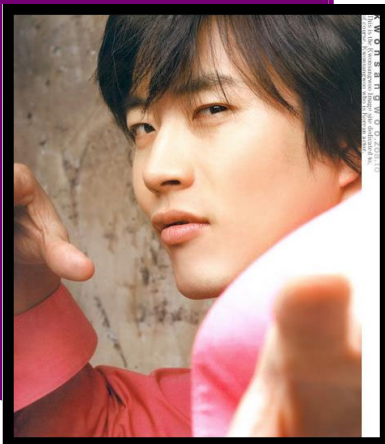
WHEN: April 11-13, 2008
